Verse of the Week

Acts 2:41 ***"41 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls."***

We celebrate this week Jesus Baptism in the Jordan River by John, His cousin.

There are many who debate the depth of the water, the location and even whether John 'dunked' Jesus. These are questions that do not change a simple fact, **"We are baptized into Jesus!"**

When Water, connected to God's Word is poured over our heads, no matter the amount, nor the method, God reaches down from heaven and reaches out His Holy Hand and makes us His children, through Water and Word. It is God Who baptizes us and makes the promise to us of eternal life. It is God Who clearly says to us, 'we are His' and that **"We are baptized into Jesus!"**

The mark of the seal of the Holy Spirit upon our head and over our heart sign, seal and deliver unto us the promises of God for all of mankind. The devil will assail us, doubt will not only enter our minds, but burden us daily and cause us to wonder if God cares for us. However, it is the promises of God that cut through the veil of doubt that surrounds us and through the Word of God can help us to believe in the certainty of God's love and His desire to keep us safe for eternity, because, **"We are baptized into Jesus!"**

When in Acts the three thousand were baptized, it was because they heard the Word of God and the offer of salvation for them. It was a clear demonstration and manifestation of God's love poured out for those who were there and heard what we hear weekly, God's Word. And their hearts were moved to seek to be baptized and learn more about what Jesus Christ did for them and for us on the Cross of Calvary. For it was God's Word and the offer of salvation that moves us to bring our children to receive the grace of God and believe that **"We are baptized into Jesus!"**

May we always hear God's offer of salvation and remember our baptism whenever and wherever it was and be reminded that **"We are baptized into Jesus!"**
