**Verse of the Week**

Matthew 28:20 ***“And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”***

It is very clear when we hear the word vision, it has different meanings for everyone. If we wear glasses, have had eye surgery or even cannot see our understanding of vision is very well defined. If we were to ask Jesus what ‘vision’ meant for Him, we would probably have heard a different definition or perspective. For Jesus vision had a goal in mind, eternity with Him. Hence, why **“Jesus calls us to fulfill His vision!”**

Jesus wants everyone to hear the Good News of our salvation and the gift of grace He offers us, through His life, death and resurrection. Jesus vision has at its root a desire for His message of grace, mercy and love to be heard and for we His people that we ‘may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him’. Because of Jesus willingness to offer us redemption that we lay claim to in the Apostle’s Creed, we in serving Him can not only discern God’s will and way, but demonstrate our commitment to Jesus life giving vision. 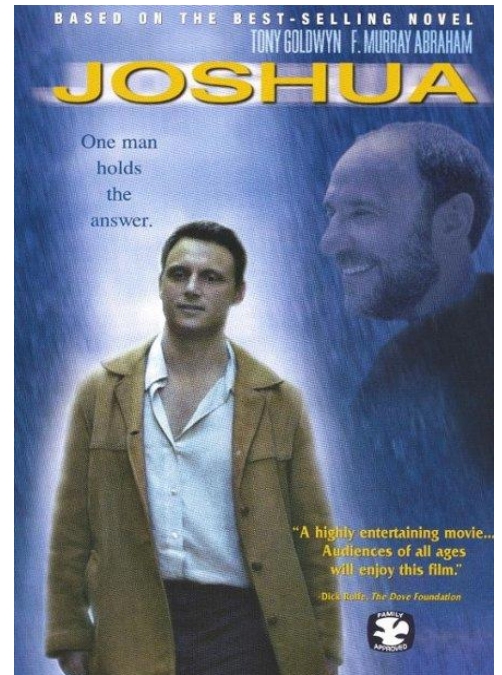
