Verse of the Week

Luke 10:16

16 “The one who hears you hears me, and the one who rejects you rejects me, and the one who rejects me rejects him who sent me.”

When Isaiah's prophecies were written approximately 750 years before Jesus birth, it was so that God would then be trusted by the Israelite people of his day. In the latest Luther's Small Catechism (2017) explanation there is a question that answers why we can and should trust God. It says, **“Question 8. Why can we be confident that the Bible is the authoritative and inerrant Word of God?...Just as God called and authorized the prophets in the Old Testament, put His words in their mouths, and fulfilled their prophecies, so also Jesus called and authorized His apostolic witnesses to speak His Word, guided by His Spirit”**.

So we in faith should trust God, because He fulfills the prophecies given by the prophets, because they are in fact His prophecies. God spoke through the prophets and if we reject the prophets, Jesus states clearly we “reject Him Who sent Me”. So in believing the prophets we not only exercise our muscle of faith, we will receive from God the greatest gift from God, **“God will bless His servant!”**

God will not only offer us the gift of eternal life, but will shower us with His deep and manifold blessings so we will then be not only encouraged, but enabled to trust Him more in our daily lives. This will help us to be a witness of His love in our world and His divine blessings that He wants to shower us with richly and without end. Yet it first takes us to trust God and what God can accomplish through His Word. For **“God will bless His servant”** when we believe Isaiah's prophecy not only about Jesus but especially about God's Word.

I close with these words written about God's Word and how **“God will bless His servant”**.

“10 “For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, 11 so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.”

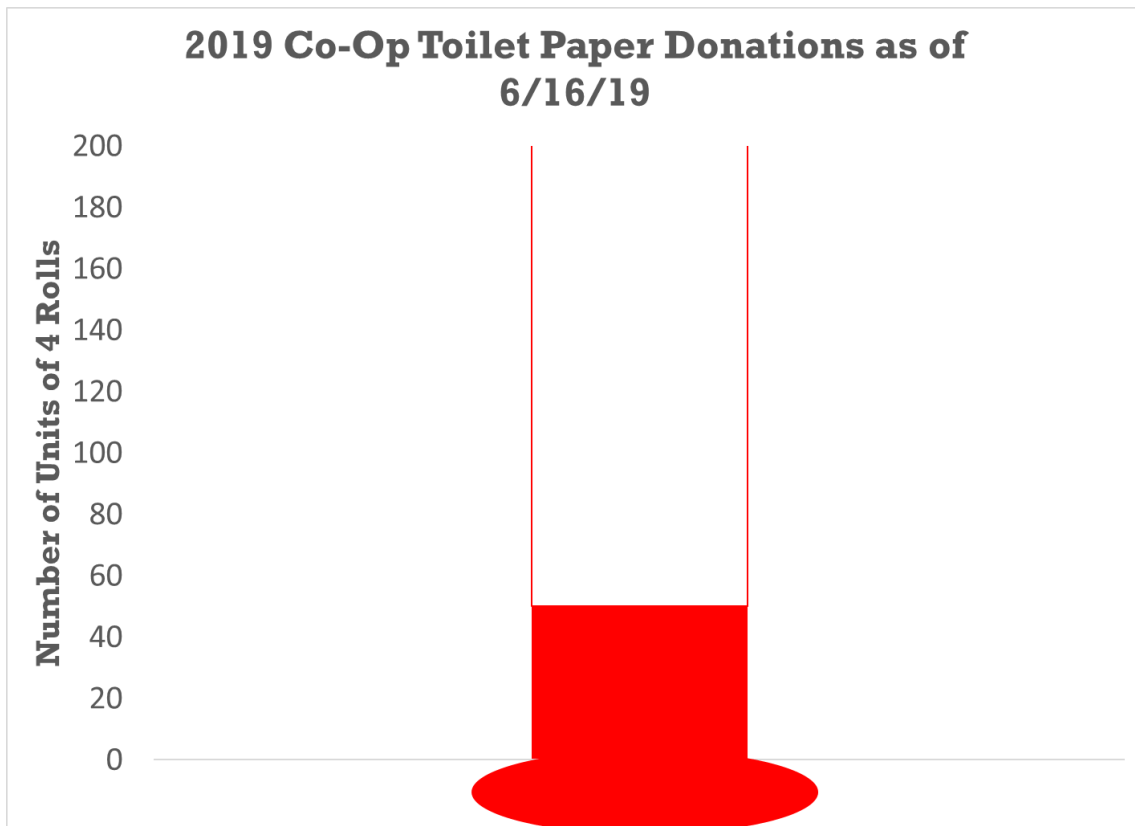
